Late Goldenrod

Preferred Water Depth and Inundation Tolerance

Prefers moist to saturated soil.

Wildlife Value

Provides cover for small mammals and songbirds.

Application/Zone

Used in upper shoreline zones, for streambank stabilization, and in vegetated swales.

Availability, Establishment, and Maintenance

- Available as divisions, stem cuttings, and seed.
- Seed germinates quickly in warm humid conditions.
- Can be aggressive and form monocultures in restorations and natural areas.
