
Purpose. To transmit Swampbuster Administrative Record Index.

Effective Date. This amendment is effective when received.

Explanation. With the increase in wetland inventories and wetland determinations, the number of swampbuster appeals is also on the increase. The attached index should be used to assemble the swampbuster administrative record into a 6-part folder. The use of the 6-part folder allows an easier review of the records contents and its technical accuracy. All swampbuster appeals to the Chief, from Wisconsin, must be organized this way. The Midwest NTC has highly recommended that all administrative records reaching Level II (area office) and Level III (state office) be organized according to this index. Information on the Administrative Record is found in NFSAM Part 510, subpart H, section 510.90 (p. 510-44).
