		<p><u>Purpose:</u> To provide for grazing on eligible Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) fields for livestock producers in need of forage in _____ <u>only</u>. CRP participants may use their CRP acreage for critical feed use or may lease the privilege to any other individual.</p> <p><u>Requirements:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants must request a modification to their CRP contract from the Farm Service Agency (FSA). • Participants will follow the requirements of the modification to their conservation plan of operation and follow the grazing requirements, as prescribed on page 2. Participants may not graze the acreage until the modified Conservation Plan of Operation is approved. The modification is only applicable for _____. • Remove livestock from CRP acreage according to the prescribed grazing plan end date, or when minimum grazing heights are present. In no case will the forage be grazed lower than a minimum height of four (4) inches for cool season grasses (Orchard, Bluegrass, Smooth Brome) and a minimum of seven (7) inches for warm season grasses (Big Bluestem, Little Bluestem, Indiangrass, Switchgrass, and any combination). At least 25 percent of each field will remain un-grazed as a refuge area for wildlife or the participant may choose to graze the entire field at a stocking rate of 75 percent or less. Refer to the attached conservation plan map for locations, approved for grazing. • Participants may not hay and graze the same acreage. • If the cover fails as a result of grazing, the producer must re-establish the CRP cover at their own expense. • Livestock will not be permitted to graze CRP cover not listed as eligible for Emergency Grazing or eligible CRP cover that is within 120 feet of any stream or permanent waterbody. For eligible practices see page 2. • Emergency Grazing is not allowed after September 30.
