

The USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) have entered into a partnership agreement through the NRCS Regional Conservation Partnership Program to address water and soil quality degradation and flood retention resource concerns in the Milwaukee River Watershed. Focus areas within the watershed include Ulao Creek, Cedar Creek, and the North Branch Milwaukee River Wildlife and Farming Heritage Area.

NRCS, MMSD, and partnering organizations will collaborate to invest over \$5 million in the project area over a 5 year period (2016 - 2021) to: 1) acquire agricultural land easements; 2) provide technical and financial assistance to landowners and farmers for conservation practice installations; 3) establish a farmer-led watershed council; 4) to demonstrate and showcase conservation practice benefits to farmers and stakeholders.
