




CRP Update

- Agricultural Act of 2014 reduces CRP acres from 32 million to 24 million by 2018.
 - October 2016 Enrollment – 23,464,447 acres
 - 2 Million Acres – Grasslands
 - Nebraska Enrollment
 - 2007 – 1,341,250 acres
 - Today – 799,237 acres
 - Reduced CRP – 542,013 acres
 - 2016 Expirations – 63,103 acres

CRP Signups

- General CRP Signup 49 – December 1, 2015 through February 26, 2016
- CRP Grassland Signup 200 – September 1, 2015
 - 2nd Ranking Cutoff - November 10, 2016
 - 3rd Ranking Cutoff – December 16, 2016 – Small Livestock Operation Initiative
- CRP Continuous Signup 48 – October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016
- CRP Continuous Signup 50 – October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017
- Platte Republican Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program Reenrollments – August 10, 2016



CRP Grasslands Signup 200

Small Livestock Operation Initiative

- 200 Acres or less
- 140 Animal Units or less

Ranking cutoff – December 16, 2016



CRP Continuous Signup 50

- Option 1 – Producers may select October 1, 2017 effective date. Offers may be:
 - Submitted to NRCS for planning
 - Approved by FSA upon plan completion



CRP Continuous Signup 50

- Option 2 – Producers may request effective date during FY17. Offers will be:
 - Accepted on first come, first served basis
 - Place in a batch process to ensure the program levels to not exceed 24 million acres
 - Approved based on notification by the National Office on a monthly basis

Note: Option 2 offers will not be referred to NRCS for planning until notified by the National Office.




Nebraska Platte - Republican Resources Area








CRP Average Soil Rental Rates
